



What is a Live-In?

While the Live-In is a retreat type of experience, it is very different from the traditional style of retreat which emphasizes silence and private prayer.

The whole purpose of the Live-In is to lead those who come to a deeper personal relationship with Jesus Christ. The people who make the Live-In seem to always experience Jesus as someone real; they experience a new peace and a deeper faith. Many people say that after the Live-In they received a new outlook on their Christian faith and their life. They found a greater meaning to their life and a new desire to pray and read the Scriptures.

The program involves teaching, sharing, testimonies...reflective time and slides on the basis of Christian life. There are a variety of speakers (priests, clergy, and lay people) from various walks of life. The entire program is instructive, uplifting, and very enjoyable. It has a good variety of activities including some recreation.
